#### **MINISTRY OF FOREIGN AFFAIRS MOURNS AMBASSADOR BEATRICE UWANI DANLADI**

The Ministry of Foreign Affairs announces, with deep sorrow and a profound sense of loss, the demise of Ambassador Beatrice Uwani Danladi, a distinguished officer of the Nigerian Foreign Service, whose death occurred on Friday, 29th May 2026, after a protracted illness. Ambassador Danladi was a dedicated career diplomat whose commitment to duty and service to the nation remained exemplary in the Ministry. Until her painful passing, she was the Director in charge of the East and Central African Division in the Ministry.

Born in Kaduna, Kaduna State, in 1974, she was a graduate of Political Science from the University of Abuja and was recruited into the Nigerian Foreign Service in 2001. Amb. Dalandi was a meticulous and unassuming officer who served the nation with loyalty and distinction. She was appointed Ambassador-insitu by the President of the Federal Republic of Nigeria in 2023. She was privileged to serve in Nigerian Missions in Cairo, Egypt; London, United Kingdom; and Madrid, Spain. Amb. Danladi was a fellow of the National Defence College, Abuja.

Her professionalism, humility, and devotion to duty earned her the respect and admiration of colleagues, friends, and associates across the Foreign Service. Her passing, therefore, represents a significant loss to the Ministry of Foreign Affairs and the diplomatic community.

The Ministry extends its heartfelt condolences to her immediate family, friends, colleagues, associates and the Government of Taraba State during this difficult period. The Ministry prays for the peaceful repose of her soul and for the Almighty God to grant her loved ones the strength and fortitude to bear this irreparable loss.
