### **NIGERIA CONDEMNS FRESH HOUTHİ ATTACKS ON SAUDI ARABIA**

The Federal Government of Nigeria strongly condemns the fresh attacks launched by the Houthi militia in Yemen against the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia, which occurred on Monday, 7 September 2026, injuring scores of civilians and damaging civil infrastructure.

Nigeria regards the fresh hostilities as serious threat not only to the security and sovereignty of Saudi Arabia but also to regional stability in the Middle East.

Nigeria, therefore, calls on all parties to uphold international law, exercise maximum restraint, and refrain from further actions that could escalate the situation, endanger civilian lives, undermine regional security, and further disrupt the flow of much-needed global energy supplies.

Nigeria stands in solidarity with the Government and people of Saudi Arabia at this difficult time, and prays for speedy recovery for those injured in the attacks.

The Federal Government of Nigeria reiterates its unwavering commitment to supporting the peace processes and conciliatory frameworks that promote regional peace, international security and stability, as well as advance shared prosperity and development for all.
